DIRECTIONS

EVERSHARP



Propel - Repel - Expel Pencils

TO WRITE: Holding the pencil with the lead away from you, turn the cap E to the right to propel the lead to writing position. Turn cap to left to repel lead.

TO REFILL: Before refilling pencil with new lead turn cap to right to expel every particle of lead. The metal ejector will appear at Tip A when the lead is expelled.

To replace lead, Hold the pencil with tip away from you, turn cap as far as it will go to the left. Slip lead completely into tip of pencil. Hold tip of pencil, with lead in place, against edge of desk and holding pencil at cap, press firmly against desk to push lead into clutch. A right turn of cap will then propel lead from the pencil, and an alternating left turn will repel lead — thus assuring that lead is safely within the clutch.

EXTRA LEAD: A generous supply of lead is contained in magazine barrel B. Expose eraser by pulling cap straight off. Do not unscrew. Braser collar is marked "Use Eversharp Eraser No. 5 or 7." This is a guide in purchasing new erasers — ask for them by the number on the eraser collar.

Remove eraser section C by pulling same with slight turning movement between thumb and first finger while holding section D with left hand. Tilt leads partly into palm of hand to select a stick of lead.

EXTENSIBLE ERASER: When worn down the rubber eraser can be extended. Remove section C with eraser from maga-

C with eraser from magazine barrel, reverse this unit to place gnurled collar against open end of D and push eraser rubber about ¼" into pencil barrel. Reverseeraser unit Cagain and place back into barrel D.

Do not expose eraser more than a necessary length above collar C. A long extension of eraser is too flexible for efficiency, is apt to break and will not permit the cap to seat properly.
