

FILLING FOUNTAIN PENS

Illustration No. 1 shows proper method to filla fountain pen. Entirely submerge Pen Point to Letter A, then snap lever shut and leave in ink five seconds. Release lever and pen will fill. Illustration No. 2 shows improper method to fill fountain pen. Pen Point

to letter B being partly submerged is filling pen with air. To properly fill follow Illustration No. 1.

When filling pen the first time, fill and expel ink several times to thor-oughly moisten feed and gold pen point.

Always mark your name and address plainly on the package so that we can identify it in connection with your letter of instructions. Always send remittance to cover cost of new parts and also include return postage. Gold pens can be repointed or straightened for 50 cents each. Repointed pens cannot be varranted to wear as well as new nor have the same quality of point as new pens. We do not recommend repointing pens smaller than No. 5.

DIRECTIONS FOR USING THE

SHEAFFERS "Propel-Repel-Expel" PENCIL Just "turn the top" to operate this pencil. A quarter turn to the eight propels the barrel. A few turns to the right ejects the lead to its full length and the metal push wire goes clear to the tip so that the lead drops out.

TO INSERT NEW LEADS: First be sure to turn the cap "A" to the left just as far as it will go. Then pull out cap "A" and remove eraser cup "C" from magazine "B." Take out a new lead and replace eraser cup and cap in barrel. Insert new lead into the tip of the barrel at "D." It will go in very easily two-thirds of the way. Then you will meet with a slight resistance. The lead is entering the lead carrier. Keep pushing firmly until a solid resistance is met, in order to properly engage the lead in the carrier. If the lead is full length, the pointwill be projecting about 1/2 of an inch, which is the proper writing length. Keep the lead always at about this length—when longer it is easily broken.

IMPORTANT

In refiling Sheaffer's "Bronel-Regel-Expel" Pencils turn cap (Point A) to right until every particle of lead is expelled at point D. Be positive and see if the Ejector or Repel Metal push wire shows at point (D) coming through carrier and until the ejector point can be seen the carrier still is occupied by a small particle of lead and it is impossible to insert a lead into the carrier until every particle is ejected. Be positive that Ejector Point shows through carrier before Refiling. This assures lead holding in carrier when refiled.

The repel feature of the Sheaffer Pencil eliminates possibility of soiling men's shirts, ladies' waists and inside of ladies' hand bags.

The symmetrical lines embodied in its construction, its patented bell shaped cap together with its patented clip eliminates wear and tear on pockets make it the most practical pencil in use.

The mechanism inserted into barrel under 30 pound pressure eliminates solder and prevents loose mechanisms.

Under size as well as over size leads that continuously cause jamming and trouble in ordinary pencils hold firmly and rigid thereby allowing full writing comforts.
