HOW TO GET PERFECT SERVICE FROM YOUR WEAREVER PEN

TO FILL – Have a clean bottle of ink. Be sure there is enough ink to completely cover the pen point. Raise lever to horizontal position. Snap lever back to its original closed position. Hold pen in ink for 15 seconds, to fill sac to maximum capacity. Withdraw pen, wipe off surplus ink, and pen is ready for use.

TO CLEAN – Flush your pen with ink several times. If pen has not been used for some time and the ink has dried, follow the general filling instructions above EXCEPT to use cold water instead of ink. This should also be done when changing inks. Allow pen to dry before filling with fresh ink.

TO INSERT NEW REPLACE-A-POINT — Be sure there is no ink in pen. Cover old point with piece of tissue, hold the point and unscrew it, using a counterclockwise motion (to the left). Insert new Replace-A-Point and screw in by means of a clockwise motion (to the right).

TO REMOVE CAP — Unscrew by usual counter-clockwise motion. Use reverse motion when replacing cap. Keep cap on securely when pen is not in use. Always hold pen with point up when removing or replacing cap.



DO'S AND DON'TS — Always keep your pen filled. A pen with little ink is more likely to flood or feed too freely. Always keep cap on pen when not in use. This keeps point moist with ink so that it will start to write instantly. Always keep pen upright to prevent flooding of inner cap. Use clip to hold pen in pocket, handbag or purse. Never raise the lever unless you hold pen over an ink bottle.
